KENT BOWL 9 PIN NO TAP RULES



Entry Fee

- The entry fee is \$35 per person for singles or doubles. \$55 to bowl both events.
- The entry fee for the April tournament will be \$46 per person. \$65 to bowl both events.
- Entry fee includes high game pot. Men and women (175 and under or 176 and over)
- All added entry money will go into the prize fund.
- \$3 per person per event will be added to the final tournament prize fund which will be held April 13, 2024.
- Monthly tournaments will pay out 6 places for each tournament singles and doubles. (% = prize fund)

1st 30% 2nd 25% 3rd 15% 4th 10% 5th 5% 6th 15%

- For the final tournament on April 13, 2024 all prize money collected through the year will be combined and split evenly so both the singles and doubles tournaments will pay the same.
- Bowlers must bowl at least 3 months by March 2, 2024 to be eligible for final tournament.

Handicap Rules

- 1. Until SEP 2023, use highest 2021 2022 book average or Kent Bowl league for 30 games or more. If current average of 30 games or more is 10 pin higher, then the higher average must be used.
- After SEP 2023 use highest 2022 2023 average or Kent Bowl league average for 30 games or more, 10 pin raise rule
 applies. Bowlers without 2021 2022 or 2022 2023 averages use highest average at the time of entry with 30 or more
 games.
- Any bowlers who wins 1st first place in two tournaments single or doubles will have their average raised 10 pins per game including April tournament.
- 4. Must bowl at least three different months by March 2, 2024 to be eligible for final tournament April 2024.
 Handicap will be 100% of 410 for doubles and 100% of 210 for singles. Maximum team average for doubles is 400.
 Minimum team average for doubles is 280. Minimum individual average for doubles is 140. Minimum individual average for singles is 140. Maximum average for singles or doubles is 220.
- 5. We reserve the right to re-rate or to refuse entry.

Special Attendance Prize 9 pin skill shot

Each bowler will receive one ticket for a drawing in the 2^{nd} & 4^{th} games. The winner of the drawing will bowl to try and roll a 9 pin tap. If the bowler leaves one pin standing he will win the progressive pot. If the bowler fails, the pot will increase in value by \$10. The pot will start at \$30 and restart at \$30 each time it is won.

Added Prizes

Triplicate Cash Awards:

\$500 for triplicate 300's in first 3 games. \$250 in games 2-3-4. Other triplicate scores will pay amount equal to score in first 3 games and half the score in games 2-3-4.

* Must get at least one pin in 10th frame last game.

Before each tournament a random score will be drawn from eggs containing scores of 150 to 250. Anyone bowling that score will receive \$10.(Must knock down at least one pin in 10th frame.)

Strike Pot Tickets

\$5 for 6 tickets or \$1 each. All money collected is paid out 100%.
